

## Changing SIM card

## Make sure you know the phone number of the card before putting it in

It is a good idea to remove all diverts before putting the card in using another phone. The unit takes a full size SIM. If the card is a mini then you will need an adapter usually available from on line sources or the local garage or post office.

The green plug will pull off complete with wires attached – when you put it back wire fixing screws face upwards

Remove the cap head bolts holding the unit down – 4mm allen/hex key

Turn unit over and look for the SIM card cover and replace SIM

Put all back and turn on

Wait for Red LED to flash slowly (Flashing quickly means no SMS connection) can take a couple of minutes

Tell the phone it has a new phone number by texting

1234TEL\*\*\*\*\*\*\*# where \*\*\*\*\* is the new phone number. TEL must be in upper case

The unit should reply with a text saying 'set success'

All other settings and any authorised numbers will remain in place
